

## CLOUD NINE

To be on cloud nine means to be extremely happy, exhilarated at what has happened.

e.g. Ever since his promotion, Peter has been on cloud nine. He hasn't stopped celebrating.



## COUNTRY COUSIN

means an unsophisticated visitor in a city, particularly one whose awkward ways are likely to embarrass his hosts.

e.g. After she was promoted to senior executive level, Julia felt like a country cousin during her first official engagement.



## C ROCODILE TEARS

means false grief, insincere sympathy.

e.g. When Andrew lost his job, all his colleagues expressed their sympathy. But these where just crocodile tears - they where glad they hadn't lost theirs.



## CUT NO ICE

means that something makes no impression or fails to influence someone.

e.g. Susan is always boasting about her success but it cuts no ice with me as I just don't believe her.



CUT THE COAT ACCORDING TO THE CLOTH

means to make the project fit the resources available; to keep your expenses within your income.

e.g. One danger of credit cards is that people forget to cut their coat according to the cloth and spend more than they earn.



DIRT CHEAP

means that something is extremely low-priced.

e.g. A customer cannot expect highest quality at a dirt-cheap price.
